



# Checklist for success

How to write a bad press release	How a good release should be
Incomprehensible headline Long lead without message News at the end Long sentences. Short cuts Scientific language Long lists of institutions taking part Important message or finding in the end Complicated quotes No applications and impact	Comprehendible headline Short lead with message News first Short an clear sentences. No short cuts No scientific language No long lists of institutions taking part Start with the important message Avoid complicated quotes Show Applications and impact

What you might take home

- Make sure you have got a message
- Choose the right target group
- Use the different instruments of PR depending on who you want to address: web / customers magazines / flyer /social media / press release etc.
- Communicate in a language that is easy to understand
- Make sure the journalist gets you right. Offer help in providing facts and figures
- Do not expect the media to react the way you think it should – just have in mind that you were looking for public awareness
